### PM Session: 6 Actions for Productive Struggle

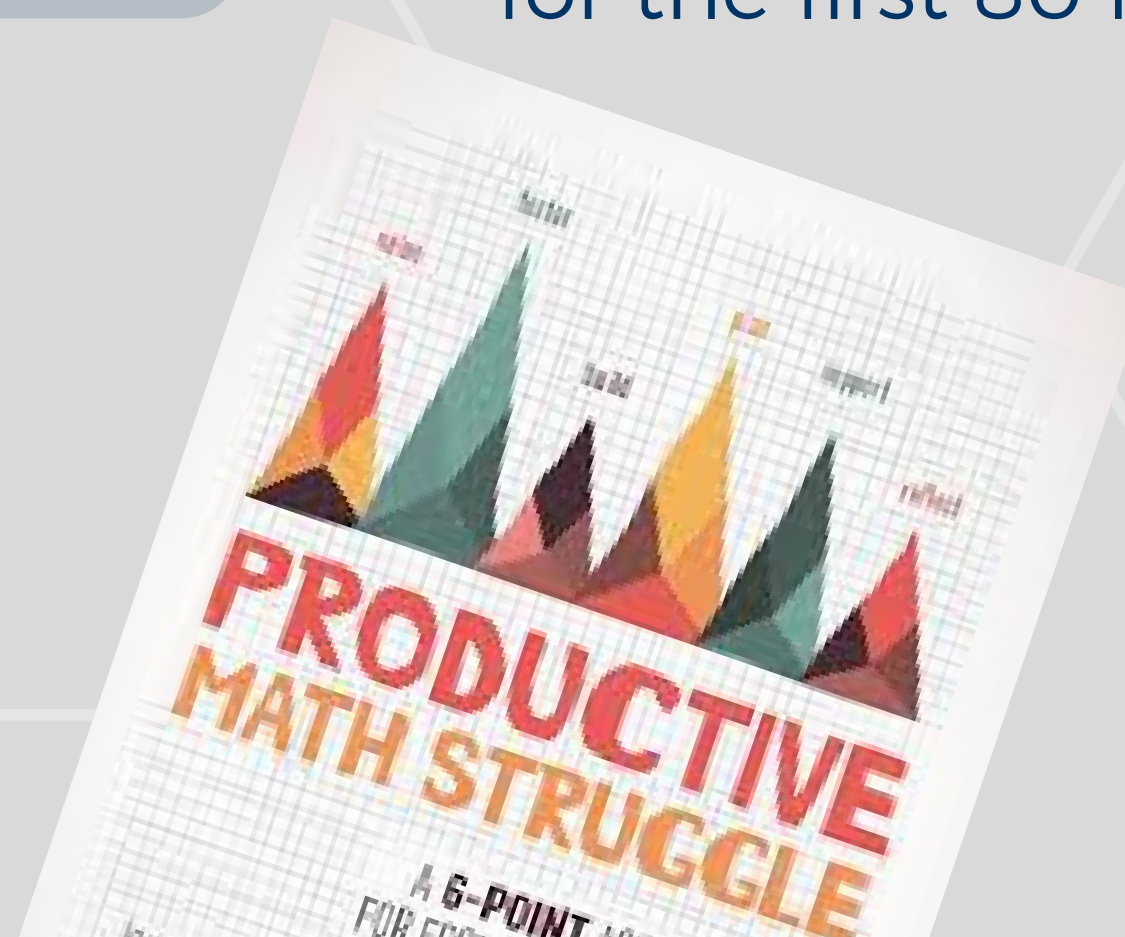
